RE: Reappointment of Professor Chinmoy Ghosh to the Gladstein Professor of
Business and Innovation in the School of Business

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Trustees reappoint Professor Chinmoy Ghosh to the Gladstein Professor of Business and Innovation in the School of Business.

BACKGROUND:

On November 9, 2010, the Board of Trustees approved the appointment of Professor Chinmoy Ghosh to the Gladstein Professor of Business and Innovation. The Gladstein Professor of Business and Innovation was established to endow a Professorship to be awarded to a nationally or internationally recognized researcher, scholar and teacher who will provide leadership in building the School's reputation focused on innovative business education and research in the areas of Finance and Accounting. This appointment will be effective from August 23, 2024, through August 22, 2027.

The decision to reappoint was made following the School of Business policy. Dean Elliott is making his recommendation based on consultation with the associate deans and the relevant department head in the School of Business.

Chinmoy Ghosh (Ph.D., Pennsylvania State University) is a tenured Professor of Finance in the School of Business and has served on the faculty at the University of Connecticut since 1986. His research focuses on the impact of corporate governance on firm value, the effect of change in disclosure regulatory on firm performance, and the effect of financial innovation on IPO valuation and performance. He has an international reputation and is widely regarded as an interdisciplinary scholar in Finance and Real Estate. He works closely with doctoral students and has distinguished service to the Department, School, and University.
