#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board of Trustees approve a Contract Extension Agreement between the University of Connecticut ("UConn" or "University") and the University of Connecticut Chapter of the American Association of University Professors ("AAUP").

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The current collective bargaining agreement between UConn and the AAUP expired on June 30, 2025, and a successor agreement has not yet been reached. Connecticut General Statutes Section 5-278a authorizes UConn and the AAUP to negotiate an extension of the expired agreement or any provisions not otherwise extended by law.

The Contract Extension Agreement will continue existing terms of conditions of employment for a period of one year, through and including June 30, 2026, or until a successor agreement has been reached, whichever comes first.
